



## UW-Madison School of Music Undergraduate Application Instructions

*Admission to the School of Music is contingent upon admission to the University, so make sure you apply to general admissions before submitting your School of Music application. Also, keep in mind that the general admissions procedure and the School of Music application/audition process are separate but concurrent processes. The School of Music evaluates prospective music majors on the basis of their application and audition, but University of Wisconsin Admissions has its own requirements and deadlines.*

The School of Music Application is available from September through January. Applicants are encouraged to apply early. Consideration for some scholarships requires audition applicants to audition at the November or January audition dates.

A complete application must include the items listed below, all of which must be received by the School of Music Undergraduate Admissions Office by the application deadline associated with your chosen audition date.

- **A School of Music application.** The application will include a short personal essay, and we also request a music resume. Please email your music resume directly to [admissions@music.wisc.edu](mailto:admissions@music.wisc.edu), using PDF or MS Word format.
- **Two recommendation letters.** The letters should come from two different sources who can recommend you based on your musical abilities, such as private teachers or ensemble conductors. Your recommender should download the PDF from the music admissions website, complete either electronically or by pen, and send via email attachment or by regular mail.
- **Voice majors only:** The School of Music can provide an accompanist for voice auditions, or you may bring your own. If you plan to use our accompanist, please send a copy of your audition music (include page numbers and your printed name on each page). Music must be received by the Undergraduate Admissions Coordinator at least 2 weeks prior to the audition date in order to allow the accompanist sufficient time to prepare.
- **Jazz majors only:** The School of Music will provide an accompanying ensemble for your audition date. Bring three (3) concert-key lead sheets of each piece you will perform at your audition for the student rhythm section.
